**7/28/09 Ward 3** At 1:30 am dispatched to **Tulane Park Apartments** in reference to an attempted vehicle theft. The vehicle window had been pulled loose to unlock door and the steering column was busted out. An observant tenant observed 2 black males leaving the vehicle in middle of parking lot then leaving complex in a silver cavalier.

**7/27/09 Ward 5** At 8 am complainant from **5500 block of Briarwood** came by headquarters to report burglary of residence. Homeowner left house at 11 am on 7/26/09 and returned at 10 pm to find it had been burglarized. Entry was gained from bathroom window. Missing was an air compressor, push dolly set, DVD's and a jug of quarters. No know suspects.

**7/25/09 Ward 6** Approximately 1:45 pm responded to **5500 block of Choctaw** in reference to burglary of a residence. Homeowner left home on 7/24/09 at 5:45 pm and returned at 1 am. Carport door was unlocked and kitchen window was open. A playstation 3 was the only thing missing.
