

CRIME ADVISORY REPORT

APRIL 2009

4-22-09 - Ward 5 - At approximately 3:45 am an observant resident called to advise of a suspicious vehicle at **Mallard Creek Apartments**. He said he saw a black male looking into a vehicle and 2 males sitting in a vehicle. When the resident parked his vehicle and starting walking to his apartment, the vehicle sped off. He was able to give a good description of the vehicle and male looking inside of vehicle. The police department stopped the vehicle and had offender identified. Suspects were arrested and charged with Burglary of Motor Vehicle, Petit Larceny – Less than \$500.00, Malicious Mischief, Possession of Burglary Tools, and Weapon Possession by Felon.

4-22-09 - Ward 3 At approximately 8 am a burglary of a vehicle was reported in the **6600 block of Camelot**. The front passenger side glass was broken out. The vehicle was last seen on 4/21 about 11:30 pm. Multiple electronics (GPS, DVD player, Apple I Pod, tools and 2 floor jacks) were taken. Neighbors did not hear anything suspicious.

4-22-09 - Ward 5 - Attempted vehicle burglary in **7300 block of Dunbarton**. The alarm on his truck went off about 3:30 am and the driver side door was partially open and he closed door and reset the alarm. At 8:30 am he called after noticing that the locking cylinder on the drivers side door had been removed. Nothing was taken from the vehicle.

4-20-09 - Ward 6 - 5500 block of Nail Road sometime between 9:30 am and 4:00 pm a red homelite weed eater and a red Troybilt push mower was stolen from under the carport. They were both seen under the carport and 9:30 am.

4-20-09 - Ward 1 - At approximately 5:00 pm a 16 foot utility trailer was reported stolen from the **7300 block of Angel**. A neighbor stated a smokey gray astro van style vehicle pulled up to the residence on the Saturday the 18th between 11 - 2 pm, hooked up the trailer and drove off.

4-20-09 - Ward 3 - In the 5600 block of West Avalon a Western .380 auto was reported stolen from the garage. It was placed on a shelf in the garage on the 17th to be cleaned and reported missing on the 20th about 7 pm.

4-20-09 - Ward 1 - Complainant from 4500 block of Shadow Ridge reported a motor vehicle burglary and stolen 4 wheeler. Over the weekend the vehicle was broken into and garage door opener was used to open garage door. The 4 wheeler was last seen in garage on the 18th. The stolen 4 wheeler was a black 2005 Honda Rincon 650. The key to the 4 wheeler was on a shelf in the garage.

4-20-09 - Ward 6 - At approximately 8:45 pm a burglary of a residence was reported from 5800 block of Fleetwood. Victim stated storage shed lock was busted and a chain saw and weed eater

was taken. The last time the missing items were seen was on the 17th. He also saw a dark colored sedan parked south of his residence but didn't think much about it at the time. He also has a camper parked in yard that the lock was busted but nothing was stolen from it.

4-18-09 - Ward 6 - 7200 Block of Northbrook - Unknown subjects attempted to steal a 8 x 12 foot utility trailer that was in the side yard of the residence. **The owner had the trailer chained to his utility building which prevented the theft.** Neighbors described a black extended cab, Chevrolet S-10 or Ford Ranger as the suspect vehicle occupied by 2 black males. They got a MS tag number of DVT-118, however that is not a good MS tag number but the truck may have some variation of that sequence of numbers on it. **IF THIS VEHICLE IS SEEN CALL THE POLICE DEPARTMENT.**

4-17-09 - Ward 1 - 5600 block of Shannon (Holly Hills). Complainant last saw tiller about 1 p.m. It was on the side of his house. He returned home at 2:30 but didn't notice it gone until 6 pm. Described as being a Craftsman green in color.

4-17-09 - Ward 5 - 7197 Mallard Creek - Regency Park Apartments - About 12:30 am a resident called to report a burglary of a vehicle in progress. The resident stated that he heard a vehicle door close and looked outside and observed a black male burglarizing a vehicle. **Thanks to his quick actions, two males were arrested for Burglary of a Motor Vehicle.** Inside the offenders' vehicle were numerous pieces of electronics (GPS, cameras, CD player, etc). These items did not come from the vehicle they had just burglarized.

4-17-09 - Ward 5 - 7100 block of Brandee a brand new radiator was taken from the back seat of a car. The radiator was placed in vehicle around 1:00 pm on 4-16 and discovered missing at 7:50 am on the 17th. The victim did not remember if doors were locked but no damage was done to vehicle.

4-17-09 - Ward 1 - Weatherstone Apartments a tile cutter was stolen from the back of a truck. The victim last saw the cutter on 4-16 at approximately 6 pm. On the 17th at approximately 7:50 am the cover had been removed and the cutter was missing. The tile cutter was valued at \$1,000.

4-16-09 Ward6 – 3800 Block Nail Road - At 8:00 am homeowner noticed his 4 wheeler missing from behind shed in back yard. It was last seen the afternoon of the 15th. It is described as a 2006 Yamaha Grizzly 660, camouflage in color.

4-22-09 - THIS CASE HAS BEEN SOLVED, A 16 YOA MALE HAS BEEN CHARGED IN THIS ROBBERY.

4-14-09 - Ward 5 - At 11:30 p.m., a black male robbed the On the Way convenience store located at 2901 Goodman Road. The suspect can be seen pulling on a black ski mask as he enters the store. He approaches the counter and pulls a small black semi automatic handgun and demands the clerk give him the money. The suspect takes the money and exits the store heading around the East side of the business on foot. No vehicle was observed leaving the area.

He was in the store less than 1 minute. The suspect was described as a young black male late teens to early twenties. 5'7" to 5'11" weighing between 150 to 180 lbs. Medium build. Suspect was wearing blue jeans, white tennis shoes, a yellow or gold t-shirt and a black letter mans jacket similar to those issued to high school players. The black jacket has yellow or gold emblems. The number 4 can be seen on the left sleeve. The emblem on the left chest may be the letter "H". On the back is the emblem of a football.

4-13-09 - Ward 2 - 2000 Block Goodman Road - Suspects entered the back fence of a business between 4/12/09 Sunday - 12:00 p.m and 4/13/09 Monday 2:30 a.m. and stole 2 riding lawn mowers. (1) Ferris Zero-turn 44" cut black/red, (1) Ferris zero-turn 61" cut black/red.

4-12-09 - Ward 5 - 2900 Block Conner Reed - Suspects stole a trailer and 4-wheeler from residence while homeowner was away. The homeowner was away from 12 to 5 p.m. that day, however a neighbor saw the trailer and 4 wheeler in tact at the residence at 2:30 p.m. Taken was a 2008 Honda TRX 420 Rancher - Hunter Green in color and a 5X7 Red Utility Trailer.

4-9-09 - Ward 6 - Suspects took items out of a garage in the 5700 block of Ashford between 5 p.m. on Wednesday the 8th and 6 a.m. on Thursday the 9th. They entered through an unlocked side door to the garage and then exited by raising the garage door. The following items were taken: craftsman leaf blower; red colored air compressor, red colored generator, and Honda push lawn mower.

4-6-09 – Ward 6 - Theft of a Craftsman air compressor from the 5400 block of Winterwood from under the carport of a residence. A neighbor said their security light came on approximately 3 am and they heard what sounded like a truck leaving at a high rate of speed, no other description was obtained.

4-5-09 – Ward 3 -Theft of trailer and riding lawn mower from 6500 block of Embassy. Maroon Chevrolet pickup was seen pulling trailer on Embassy around the same time frame of about 2:45 p.m, this could possibly be related to the theft.

4-2-09 – Ward 5 - Theft of 6 x 12 ft red utility trailer parked on side of a house in the 7300 block of Dunbarton. Dogs were barking at 3:00 am and the trailer was discovered missing at 7:00 am that morning.

4-2-09 – Ward 5 - Theft of a 16 ft red utility trailer parked on street in the 7300 block of Dunbarton. The trailer was last seen at 12:30 pm on the 1st and reported stolen at 2:30 p.m on the 2nd.
