

Crime Advisory Report

May 2009

5/24/09 Ward 1 At approximately 3 pm we were dispatched to the **7300 block of Northbrook Cove** for attempted theft of a pressure washer. Homeowners arrived home and caught suspect in his attempt. They got the tag number and hlpd officers were able to apprehend the suspect.

5/24/09 Ward 6 At approximately 1:30 am we were dispatched to **5200 block of Caroline** in reference to burglary of a residence. Homeowner advised he went to work around 11:30 on 5/23 and returned home at 1:30 on 5/24 and noticed his carport door was wide open. Items taken included a TV, receiver box, cell phone and an entire baseball card collection. Homeowner does have possible suspect information.

5/23/09 Ward 2 At approximately 5:40 pm we were dispatched to **Ryan's Steakhouse** in reference to a burglary of a vehicle. They arrived about 5 pm and parked near the front entrance. A woman's purse and GPS system was taken. Security cameras were down at the time.

5/23/09 Ward 6 At approximately 5:30 pm we were dispatched to the **5200 block of Nail Road** in reference to a stolen lawnmower. Homeowner left residence at 7:00 am and returned at 4:30 pm to notice mower was missing from under carport. The neighbors on each side did not see or hear anything.

5/23/09 Ward 2 At approximately 10:30 am we were dispatched to the **2000 block of Goodman** in reference to a stolen lawnmower. Resident left at 9:00 am and returned at 10:00 am to notice that lawn mower and gas operated edger was missing.

5-20-09 Ward 1 - Approximately 6:15 pm we were dispatched to **Weatherstone Apartments** for vandalism to a vehicle. Upon arriving on scene, a total of 8 vehicles had been scratched on hoods or trunk. Damage to vehicles was done by juveniles.

5-20-09 Ward 4 - Approximately 6:45 pm dispatched to **3200 block of Fairmeadow** for stolen lawn mower and gas trimmer. Homeowner last saw both of them at 6:00 am. Arrived home at 5:00 pm and they were missing. Neighbors did not see or hear anything.

5-20-09 Ward 1 - Approximately 6:30 pm dispatched to **7400 block of Northbrook** in reference to burglary of a residence. Homeowner stated he left home 8:00 am on 5/16/09 and returned at 6:30 pm on today's date and discovered TV missing.

5-20-09 Ward 2 - Dispatched to **Sleep Inn** approximately 6:45 am for burglary of vehicle. Upon arrival a total of 4 vehicles had the driver side door lock punched out. Only 1 vehicle had something taken which was a label maker and checks to a closed bank account.

5/18/09 Ward 1 - Dispatched to **7136 Highway 301** a few minutes after midnight in reference to a stolen lawn mower. Homeowner left for work at approximately 8:30 am on the day before. Upon returning at 11 pm he noticed lawn mower missing from under porch. A neighbor stated he

saw a man knocking on his door and then when he left he had something large wrapped in back of his truck which was a brown 1997 S-10 pick-up. He also noticed a large amount and variety of tools missing from camper topper.

5-17-09 Ward 6 - Dispatched to **5600 block of Patricia** at 6:40 pm in reference to a stolen lawn mower. Homeowner last saw it at 11 am on this date and returned home at 6 pm. The lawn mower was taken from garage.

5-17-09 Ward 6 - Dispatched to **5500 block of Winterwood** at approximately 8 am for a theft of riding lawn mower. Last seen between the date of 5/16/09 approximately 5:30 pm and 5/17/09 at 2:00 am. It was stolen from carport. Neighbor stated they did not see or hear anything.

5-10-09 Ward 3 - At approximately 3:05 pm we were dispatched to **5600 block of West Avalon** in regard to burglary of a residence. Victim stated last time property was seen was on 5-01 about noon and returned home on 5-04-09. Noticed on 5-10 that jewelry, money and alcohol was missing. There were no signs of forced entry to the home.

5-10-09 Ward 6 - At approximately 10:55 am were dispatched to the **5000 block of Gray Drive** in reference to burglary of residential storage room that is attached to home. The victim locked storage room door at 8 pm and went to bed about 10:30. Lawn equipment (mower, weed eater, blower) tools and camping equipment were taken.

5-09-09 Ward 3 - At approximately 10:20 am we were dispatched to the **6600 block of Ridgewood** in reference to a motor vehicle theft from residence. The victim stated he last saw his red 2004 Chevrolet Venture passenger van in his driveway the night of 5-08-09 at 11 pm. He was preparing to leave for work at 5 am on 5-09 when he saw his van was gone. The vehicle has a Colonial Hills Church sticker in the back window.

5-09-09 Ward 2 - At approximately 6:30 pm we were dispatched to **1600 block of Joy Circle** regarding the theft of a lawnmower. A neighbor stated they heard the victims dog barking about 11 pm the night before but did not see anyone.

5-08-09 Ward 2 - At approximately 12:42 pm we were notified of an attempted vehicle burglary that just occurred on **Cracker Barrel parking lot**. It was witnessed by Memphis Police Detectives. The suspects were later arrested after trying to break into another vehicle in Tunica County.

5-08-09 - Ward 2 - At 1:30 am we were dispatched to **Bob Bo's** in reference to a burglary of a vehicle. The vehicle was last seen in tact about 10:30pm. The front driver's side window had been broken out. The owner stated that nothing appeared to be stolen.

5-06-09 - Ward 3 - Approximately 8:30 am we received a call to **6800 block of Embassy** for report of vandalism to a vehicle. From 5-03-09 at 5 pm to 5-05-09 at 6:30 pm, someone stuck an object into the drivers side door lock and damaged lock and scratched the paint. It appeared someone attempted to gain entry. The neighbors did not see or hear anything.

5-05-09 - Ward 4 - Approximately 12:07 pm we received a call to **3800 block of Heathcliff** for report of a stolen clothes dryer. The dryer was under the carport and last seen the day before between the hours of 10 am and 3 pm.

5-4-09 - Ward 4 - Approximately 7:30 pm we received a call to the **3500 block of Lakehurst** regarding burglary of a vehicle. Vehicle was last seen in tact around 9:30 the night before. Vehicle owner was attempting to change a flat tire when she noticed that the back window was unzipped. The only damage was to dash board and glove box. Stolen items included trailer hitch, receiver, jack and a radio/satellite/cd player.

5-4-09 - Ward 4 - Approximately 8 pm we received a call to **3400 block of Laurelwood** regarding burglary of a residence. Homeowner left home about 10 am and just returned home noticing gate to back yard open. Entry in the home revealed items all over the floor. Both TV's were lying on floor partially covered with blankets. Bedroom window was raised and muddy footprints leading into home. Items stolen included cash, computer system, and 2 DVD players.

5-02-09 - Ward 3 - 6800 block of Embassy a vehicle was broken into. Homeowner stated at 4 am the alarm activated on his vehicle. He saw the dome light on and did a quick observation but did not notice any damage or anything missing. Approximately 8:30 am he noticed that the key hole and handle of door was damaged.

5-01-09 - Ward 3 - 2400 block of Lasonya a residence was burglarized. The homeowner left for work at 2 pm and returned about midnight. He noticed that his garage door was open. The rear back door had been preyed open to gain entry. After gaining entry the offender probably pulled in the garage to load vehicle with TV's, computers, and firearms.

5-1-09 - Ward 1 - Victim reported that his storage unit at **301 Mini Storage** unit was burglarized. Missing was a computer, stereo system, TV, chainsaw and a gas edger. Victim had not been to the storage unit in 2 weeks before discovery of the break in.
