6/27/09 - Ward 3 At 7:30 pm dispatched to 3300 block of Goodman **Wash-N-Go Carwash** in reference to money missing from a coin changer. According to surveillance camera, theft occurred on 6/26/09 at approximately 9:25 pm using a method known as “stringing”. The suspect appears to be a white male early to mid 20’s driving a 2000 model GMC Sierra with a billet grill and missing a rim on rear passenger side of vehicle.

6/27/09 - Ward 2 Dispatched to **Audobon Point Mini Storage** in reference to burglary of camper trailer. The camper was last seen on 5-31-09. Plasma TV and mounting brackets missing.
