Senior College Scholarship Application Guide**

- ◆ Scholarship awards will be applicable to the 2023/2024 school year
- ◆ Two (2) scholarships totaling \$1,000.00 each will be awarded to two (2) students for the 2023/2024 school year
- ◆ Scholarships are available to U.S. Citizens entering a Mississippi senior college in any year (Freshman, Sophomore, Junior, or Senior) as an Undergraduate
- ◆ Community Colleges are not applicable for this scholarship
- ◆ No student will be eligible to receive more than one (1) NMMA scholarship per lifetime
- ◆ Students may utilize scholarship funds to cover tuition, books or fees
- ◆ Mayors may distribute application forms in their community (counties included in the NMMA area only) beginning November 1, 2022
- ◆ Applications must be received by Three Rivers Planning and Development District no later than January 31, 2023.
- ◆ The NMMA will appoint an independent committee (not comprised of any Mayors) to review applications and select scholarship recipients
- ◆ Scholarship awards will be announced no later than April 1, 2023, for the Fall 2023/Spring 2024 school year
