Mr. Dalhight also said he preferred a privacy fence on the east side of the property, since the trees would lose their leaves in the winter. *At this time, Mayor Latimer called on Willie Davidson, Planning Director, to present Case No. 1926-Request for Site Plan approval-3515 Goodman Road W (appeal from Planning Commission). Mr. Davidson presented the Staff Report and stated that the Planning Commission had denied site plan approval, but the applicant had filed an appeal. Mike Davis with The Reaves Firm was present, along with the applicant. Alderman Jones confirmed that 2-way traffic was proposed on both Goodman and Dunbarton. Alderman Guice asked if there had been any neighborhood comments. Mr. Davidson said that the planning department had received no comments. Alderman Bostick stated that he agreed with the Planning Commission decision, and there were plenty of other areas in the City for the proposed business to locate. Alderman Jones stated there had already been some bad accidents at Dunbarton, and there would likely be more with people turning into the proposed business off Goodman Road; he noted there was no Goodman Road access for the Waffle House across Goodman Road from the subject property. Alderman Johnson said that she lives on Dunbarton (north of Goodman Road) and is concerned with the traffic. She asked if Goodman Road access was necessary. Mr. Davidson said yes, it was. Alderman Roberts said that he was aware of no neighborhood opposition, and, in fact, the church across Dunbarton from the subject property was excited about the proposed business. Mr. Davis said they scheduled a meeting at the church a few days after Memorial Day and put signs on the project site and on both sides of Dunbarton. No residents appeared at the meeting, but the church officials were positive about the proposed use of the property. Mr. Davis said they left the project boards in the church's assembly hall for about 3 months. Mr. Davis said the property owner immediately to the south is a family member of the current owner of the subject property, and has no issue with the site plan or proposed business. Mr. Davis said the traffic engineers with the City Engineer's office (Neel-Schaffer) had reviewed the plan and indicated there needed to be 2-way traffic, but the applicant is open to the option of the Goodman Road access being right-in, right-out. Mr. Davis acknowledged that a buffer of 30' is typical, but they can't fit

the building on the property with that wide of a buffer. He said their plan has enough parking, but not enough queue; but he said the proposed business was not like a McDonald's or Chick-fil-A, there was no standard peak time, and the business only averaged about 10-12 customers per hour at its peak. Mr. Davis said that MDOT had no issues with their access, so long as the existing curb cut is used. He said the proposed hours of operation would be approximately 10:00 am - 10:00 pm. Alderman Jones asked if that was 7-days per week, and the answer was yes. Alderman Bostick, again, stated that he supported Baskin Robbins, but at a different location. Mr. Davis said the subdivision was platted long before Goodman Road became what it is today, and that there was never going to be a house built on the property. The appeal hearing was concluded.

*At this time, Mayor Latimer opened the public hearing on Case No. 1928-Text Amendment to the Zoning Ordinance regarding Solar Panel and Solar Farms. Mayor Latimer called on Willie Davidson,

Planning Director, who presented the Staff Report and said that he had received one or more recent inquiries about solar panels and the possible development of a solar farm. Mr. Davidson stated that the City's current zoning ordinance does not adequately address such uses, and thus the need for the proposed amendments. No one appeared to speak or offer evidence against the proposed amendments. The public hearing was declared closed.

Ordinance #19-09-260

ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF HORN LAKE, MISSISSIPPI, AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE, BY DEFINING AND REGULATING SOLAR ENERGY SYSTEMS

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Horn Lake, Mississippi, are empowered, pursuant to Chapter 1 of Title 17 of the Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, to establish, enforce, amend, supplement, or change zoning regulations; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 21-19-1 et seq., of the Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen have the power to make regulations to secure the general health of the City; to preserve good order and peace of the City; and to adopt codes dealing with general public health, safety, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to § Section 21-17-5, of the Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen have the authority to adopt any orders, resolutions, or ordinances with respect to the municipal affairs of the City, which are not inconsistent with the Mississippi Constitution of 1890 or any other statute or law of the State; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen have found and determined that it is necessary for the promotion and protection of the health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of the City to amend the Zoning Ordinance to define and regulate solar energy systems; and

WHEREAS, the City of Horn Lake Planning Commission (the "Planning Commission") scheduled a public hearing on the proposed amendments, at which the Planning Commission reviewed, considered, and approved the proposed amendments, and did thereafter, forward its recommendation to the Mayor and Board of Aldermen; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen scheduled a public hearing on the proposed amendments for the 17th day of September, 2019, at 6:00 o'clock p.m.; and

WHEREAS, notice of the September 17, 2019 public hearing was published in the DeSoto Times-Tribune, a newspaper published, or of general circulation, in the City of Horn Lake, DeSoto County, Mississippi, in the manner and for the time required by law, and as shown by proof of publication on file; and

WHEREAS, at the time, date and place specified in the notice, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen did conduct a public hearing and received the Planning Commission's recommendation for approval, the Staff Report, and comments and/or evidence on the proposed amendments from those in attendance; no one objected to the proposed amendments; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen are familiar with the properties and existing land uses/regulations within the City, and in acting on this Ordinance, have duly considered the matters and facts within their personal knowledge; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen have found and determined that the following regulations as set forth in this Ordinance are in the best interest of the citizens of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Horn Lake, Mississippi, as follows:

SECTION 1. That all the findings of fact made and set forth in the preamble to this Ordinance shall be and the same are hereby found, declared and adjudicated to be true and correct.

SECTION 2. That the definition of "Accessory Use" in Appendix A, ARTICLE II. – Definitions, Section B. Definitions of the Code of Ordinances, City of Horn Lake, Mississippi, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Accessory Use – A subordinate use which is incidental to and customary in connection with the principal building or use and located on the same lot, including, but not limited to, landscaping features, walls, fences, light fixtures, steps, paving, sidewalks, shutters, awnings, solar panels, satellite dishes, and signs.

SECTION 3. That Appendix A, ARTICLE II. – Definitions, Section B. Definitions of the Code of Ordinances, City of Horn Lake, Mississippi, is hereby amended by adding the following definition:

Solar Energy System – Systems intended to collect solar energy for the purposes of conversion into useable electricity, to heat water, home heating, etc. including but not limited to photovoltaic (PV) cells mounted on roofs, poles, or ground, other solar collector panels or units, solar integrated roofing panels, solar water heaters, etc.

SECTION 4. That Appendix A, ARTICLE V. – General Provisions and Supplemental Zoning District Regulations of the Code of Ordinances, City of Horn Lake, Mississippi, is hereby amended by adding the following:

S. – SOLAR ENERGY SYSTEMS

1. Photovoltaic Solar Energy Systems. A photovoltaic solar energy system ("solar energy system") is permitted in all zoning districts as an accessory use to a principal use. A solar energy system is considered an accessory use when the power generated from the solar energy system is equal to or less than the expected power usage of the principal use and any other accessory use on the property. The installation and construction of a solar energy system shall be subject to the following design standards and installations:

- a. In all Commercial zoning districts any solar energy system shall be required to meet front, side and rear, set-backs as set forth in the applicable zoning district.
- b. In all residential districts, no portion of a solar energy system shall be located within or above any front yard, or side corner yard.
- c. In all residential districts that have roof mounted solar energy systems, installations are to lay flat, and cannot exceed the principal building height in the applicable zoning district.
- d. A ground mounted or pole mounted system, measured when oriented at maximum design tilt shall not exceed the maximum building height in the applicable zoning district.
- e. Ground mounted and pole mounted solar energy systems shall be located so that any glare is directed away from any adjoining property and maybe subject to screening, capable of

providing year round screening along the non-reflective sides of the solar collection device.

- f. In all residential zoning districts that have a ground mounted or pole mounted solar energy system, the setback distance from the rear and side property lines, measured when the system is oriented at minimum design tilt, shall be equivalent to the building setback of the applicable zoning district.
- g. An electrical permit shall be obtained before installation. Any electrical work shall be done by a licensed electrician. All electrical lines shall be buried underground at a minimum distance of twelve inches (12"). All lines that are attached to house shall be secured and fastened.
- h. A building permit shall be obtained when structural and wind loads are a concern and when needing extensive racking and/or footings.
- i. Any solar energy system that has not been in use for its original purpose for a period of one hundred eighty (180) days shall be deemed to be abandoned. The solar energy system owner and/or property owner shall have an additional ninety (90) days to remove the abandoned solar energy system or to reactivate the solar energy system.

SECTION 5. That Appendix A, ARTICLE XII. – Use Chart of the Code of Ordinances, City of Horn Lake, Mississippi, is hereby amended by including "Solar Farm" as a permitted use in the M1 Light Industrial, M2 Heavy Industrial, and AR Agricultural-Residential Zoning Districts, with the following footnote:

Footnote #36 Solar Farm:

- 1. Minimum lot size ten (10) acres.
- 2. A minimum setback of fifty (50) feet must be maintained on all property lines. Solar panels will be kept at least five hundred (500) feet from a residence that is not a part of the Special Use.
- 3. Ground mounted panels shall have a height maximum of ten (10) feet.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall become effective and be in full force from and after being certified by the City Clerk, signed by the Mayor or Board Majority, recorded in the ordinance book, published and after waiting one month after the date of passage.

After first having been reduced to writing, then read and considered section by section and as a whole by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen, a motion was properly made by Alderman Roberts and duly seconded by Alderman Jones for the adoption of this ordinance.
