



Dear City of Horn Lake,

Meridian Waste would like to provide clarification regarding non-curbside collection service for disabled residents.

Under this policy, a disabled person is defined as an owner of a residential service unit who is unable to place their residential municipal solid waste at the designated curbside collection location due to a disability. In these situations, the resident may qualify for non-curbside collection service.

To qualify for non-curbside collection, the resident must meet the following requirements:

1. The resident must provide a doctor's note certifying the disability.
2. The doctor's note must be provided to both the City of Horn Lake and Meridian Waste.
3. No other able-bodied individual may reside within the residential unit who is capable of placing the waste at the designated collection location.

Non-curbside collection will apply only to residential municipal solid waste service. It does not include bulk waste, yard waste, commercial waste, or any other non-residential service.

Meridian Waste is committed to working with the City of Horn Lake to ensure residents who meet these requirements receive the proper service while maintaining a clear and consistent process.
